Note: The budget for 2011 for the COA and all affiliated agencies provided funding for a total of 8440 persons, including: 4646 full-time staff, 197 hirees, 322 contract employees, 9 security personnel, 2686 technicians, 217 drivers, and 363 custodial workers. The COA per se (i.e. excluding affiliated agencies) accounted for 425 of these persons, including 332 full-time staff, 15 hirees, 10 contract employees, 9 security personnel, 14 technicians, 29 drivers, and 16 custodial workers.
